

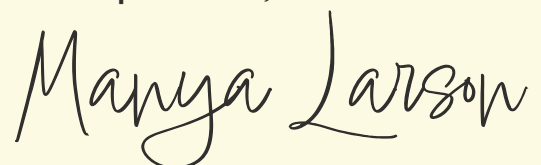
As someone who values “putting your money where your mouth is”, I am excited to lean in to support something I deeply believe in through Board service at Breadroot Co-op.
